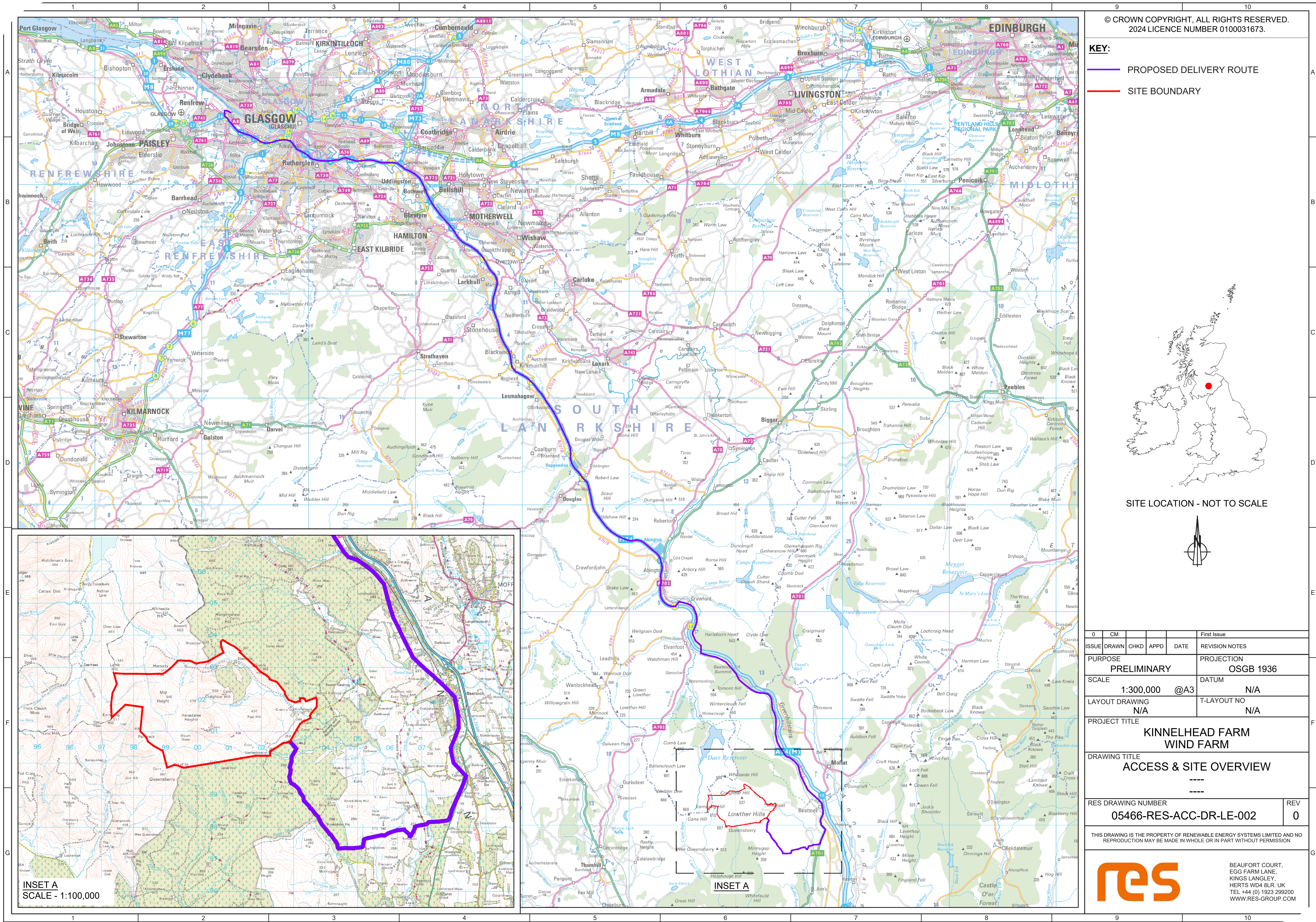


Transport and access



Transport is one of the key considerations when selecting a potential wind farm site, particularly with regard to the turbine deliveries.

The delivery route for turbine components is expected to be via the M74 and A701.

Safety is of utmost importance to RES and we will be undertaking a detailed swept path analysis of the turbine delivery route, as well as careful assessment of the main site access options. The preferred access point and turbine delivery route are shown on the map above.

Over the next few months, we will consult with the local authorities including the local authorities and Transport Scotland on our transport plans.

A transport assessment will be undertaken and, if the wind farm is given consent, a detailed Traffic Management Plan will be agreed with the roads authority and the police.

Wherever reasonably practicable we will use materials available on site and source construction materials locally in order to help reduce traffic movements.
