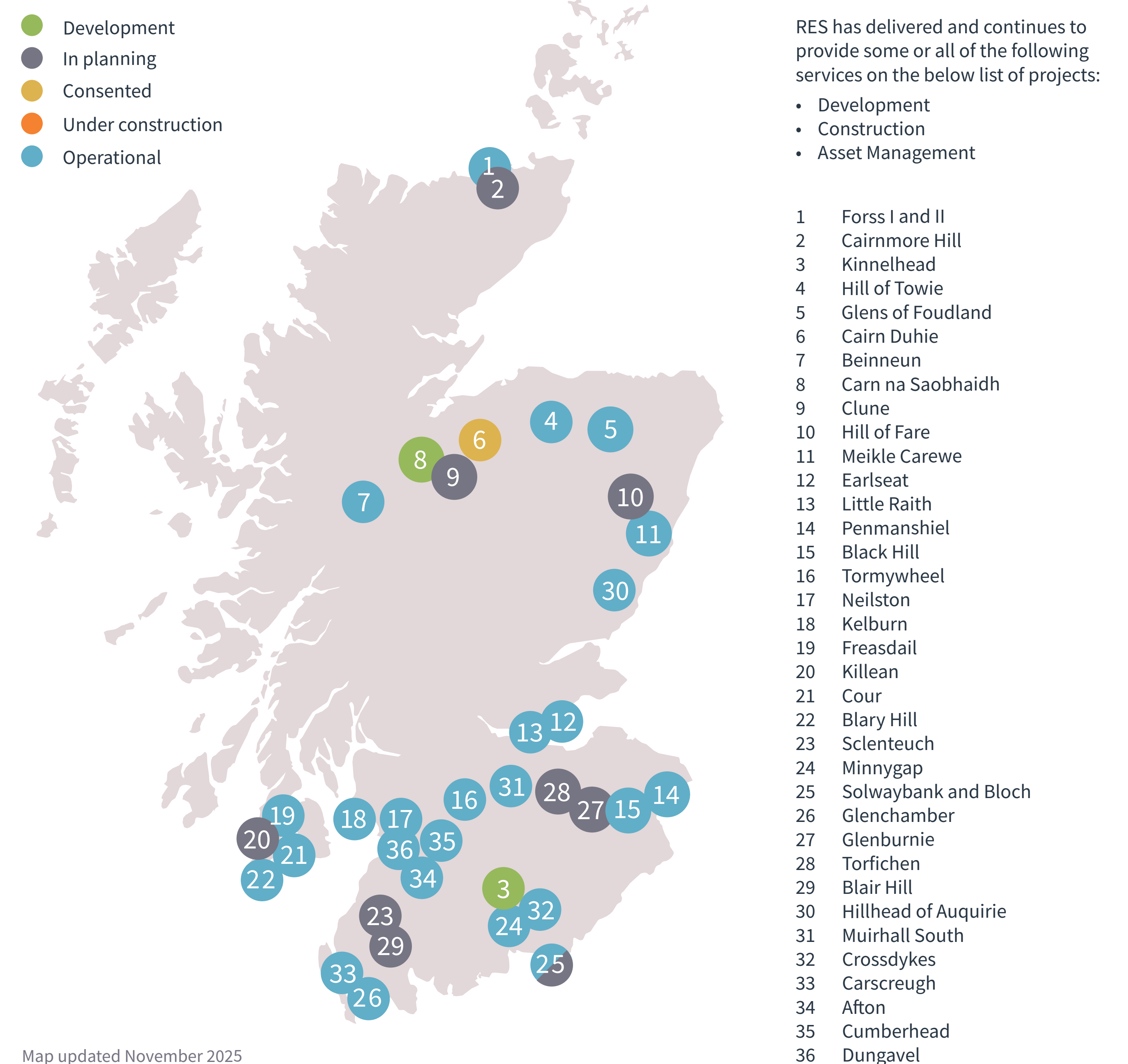
Partnership
